## APRIL 2011 BOARD REPORT

At the April meeting of the Board of Directors' of Tri-County Electric Cooperative, the board reviewed the following items:

- The board reviewed and approved minutes.
- The board had a conference call with cooperative auditor Larry Lume from Schmidt & Co. After the conference call the board went to executive session with the auditor.
- The board had Lou Toth, Toth and Associates, present a four year work plan. The board discussed and approved the work plan.
- The board approved an amendment to the 2011 capital budget.
- The board reviewed and approved 219's for construction work done over the last 6 months.
- David Ramsey, General Manager gave his monthly report. He discussed the following:
